### 1. TUITION FEES:

The tuition fees for the 2012-2013 academic year are €47.40 per credit for first enrolments, €23.70 per credit for second enrolments and €30.81 per credit for third or subsequent enrolments.

### 2. PAYMENT OF TUITION FEES: (FIRST FULL COURSE ENROLMENT)

2.1. Options for paying tuition fees:

2.2. Students who withdraw or cancel their registration once instruction has begun at the University of Cordoba will not be entitled to a refund and will be required to pay the tuition fees in full for that academic year.

2.3. Students will be charged for any costs incurred when a direct debit is unpaid.

2.4. Students who choose the bank deposit payment option (*pago por entidad financiera*) can pay their tuition fees at any Banco Santander branch using the receipt of payment form that is automatically printed out once the self-registration process has finalized.

2.5. SIBLING FEE WAIVER: Sibling students registered full time are eligible for a fee waiver of 200€ each.

### **3. REGISTRATION FEES:**

In addition to the tuition fees, students registered at the “Sagrado Corazón” Teacher Training School are required to pay the UCO 30% of the official fees upon enrolment. They will also be charged for the Student Card (*Tarjeta Universitaria*) and mandatory insurance coverage. The UCO also offers students Optional Accident Insurance, which the school recommends.

Students belonging to families with five or more children (*familia numerosa especial*) and those who have applied for a MEC scholarship are exempt from paying the public fees, while those who belong to families with up to four children (*familia numerosa general*) will be charged 50%.

For students who choose the bank deposit payment option (*pago por entidad financiera*), the payment form for the fees described in section 3 will be automatically printed out once the self-registration process has finalized.

### **4. OTHER FEES:**

Students will be charged a one-time fee of €44.30 to cover administrative expenses in the first payment instalment. This fee will not be refundable under any circumstances, even in the event that the student withdraws by the deadline.

Students wishing to transfer credits will be charged €14.22 by the school per credit transferred, as well as 30% of the public fees per credit by the University of Cordoba.

### **5. PROCESSING OF TUITION FEES:**

Once self-registration has been completed and the documents have been submitted to the Self-Registration Office, students registered at the school must:

5.1. Provide direct billing forms to authorize payment of the “Sagrado Corazón” tuition fees (MT011) and the public fees of the University of Cordoba (MT003) in the event that they have changed their bank account.

5.2. Students who choose the bank deposit payment option (*pago por entidad financiera*) must submit proof of payment duly stamped by the financial institution where the payment was made.

For any questions regarding economic matters, students are requested to contact the School Administrator in writing to explain their financial difficulties and seek a common solution.
